



Medicaid Verification Documents

Identity Verification

- Acceptable documents: Birth certificates, driver's licenses, state or federal IDs, Social Security cards, passports, military ID, award letters, Medicare card

Proof of Florida Residency

- Acceptable documents: Utility bills, rent/mortgage receipts, employer pay stubs, documents showing a Florida address

Income Verification

- Acceptable documents: Recent pay stubs (last 30 days), annual tax return, bank statements, SSI/VA/social support award letters, unemployment benefits

Document Type	Reason / Usage
Income Proof	Pay stubs, bank statements, benefit letters (income eligibility)
Residency Verification	Utility bills, lease agreements, rent receipts
Identity Documents	IDs, birth certificates, Social Security, etc.
Miscellaneous Forms	Medicaid-specific DCF forms (e.g., consent, disclosures)
Medical/Expense Documents	Medical bills, proof of loss-of-income, etc.
